



Keene Memorial Library Rules of Conduct

THE LIBRARY DOES NOT ALLOW:

- Smoking/tobacco use
 - Sleeping
 - Loitering
- Disruptive behavior
- Food or uncovered drinks
 - Soliciting or selling
- Improper use of restrooms
 - Inappropriate dress
- Excessive size and/or number of bags
 - Alcohol or drugs
- Carrying firearms and/or other weapons.

INTERNET USE:

- See the Computer and Internet Use Policy Form

CHILDREN IN THE LIBRARY:

- Any child 10 years and under shall be attended (remain in sight of) and supervised by either a parent or care-giver.
- Children 11 years and older may use the library unattended, subject to the rules and regulations of the library.

CELL PHONE USE:

- Cell phones must be set to vibrate or turned off
- Cell phone use limited to Lobby area or outside

LIBRARY POLICIES:

- Failure to comply with library staff requests may result in suspension of library privileges.
 - Theft or damage of library materials is a serious offense and may lead to arrest.
 - Trespassers will be prosecuted.
 - Patrons must have card present to use library services
- Cards exceeding \$10 in fines or fees lose privileges until reduced
