



Auditorium Renovation Facts

The City Auditorium, built in 1937, served our community for nearly a century, but was in desperate need of repairs.

A Needs Assessment and Feasibility Study was conducted in 2015 to determine the best course of action for the auditorium's future. With an average of 170 events per year, renovation was the clear choice.

A steering committee was formed and on May 10, 2017, a public meeting was held to gather public input on the conceptual designs. The input from this meeting was put to use and translates to what you see before you today.

Cheever Construction, out of Lincoln, NE was the general contractor for the remodel and Schemmer, out of Omaha, NE handled the architectural and engineering aspects. The renovations took a year and a half to complete.

The renovation budget was \$3,875,000 which was comprised of a combination of a \$2 million bond approved by Fremont voters, a \$1.125 million Civic and Community Center Financing Fund grant from the Nebraska Department of Economic Development and a City Council approved budget of \$750,000. The renovations came in under budget by over \$400,000.
